

Curling Club Meeting 11/12/14

Meeting called to order at 6:07 by President Lou Hubert.

Glen to discuss financials: Insurance of building and liability payment of \$1943 has been taken care of. Purchase of stone conditioner \$382.69, new vacuums and carpet totaling \$1051.52. Some dues have already been coming in, with a total of 1023.24. Permission was asked to deposit \$10,000 into a CD or Money Market account. Was decided to place funds in a Money Market account with a higher yield. Approved.

Walt and Dan to discuss camera system information that has been received. A closed circuit system previously approved in moving forward, Dan has brought to the table three choices for selection. Each selection would be able to upgrade at any time. Step 1 upgrade the current system with 2 cameras and 19" flat screen TVs \$900.00 Step 2, 4 camera multiplex system including 40" flat screen tv for downstairs viewing \$2000. Step 3 would have 2 cameras and also 4 bullet cameras showing sheet of ice as well including the TV for \$2,200. Randy made note of how much we will actually be using the cameras. Mainly for bonspiels, international and playoffs. Justify the amount of time being used at this time. Walt made a motion to start with step 1 \$900 as it is very easy to upgrade, with also running cable while up there for the upgrades to be easily done at any time. Seconded by Dan and all approved. Dan, Joe and Lou will begin work on it Nov. 22nd at 11 am, figuring about 3-4 hours of work to complete. It was also suggested that we go see Ron Johnson from ABC Warehouse in Gaylord to see if we would be able to get a possible better deal on TVs.

Randy: Advertising, Randy called our rep to deal with advertising and he declined working on ads at this time with his busy schedule. Randy took it upon himself to go solicit the current advertisers and possible gain a few new ones. He was very successful and renewed and sold new ads totaling just over \$2000.

International is full! We have 6 teams from Detroit, 3 from Sault, 2 from Bowling Green, 2 from Columbus and 2 from Traverse. 5 teams will come from LCC.

Jeff: asked Jen to check on USCA signups and I will get totals and send to him.

Mixed Regionals, signup deadline is Jan 16th, 2015 with the spiel on the 31st in Lewiston. Need to work on signage.
